

CUSTOMER-OWNED TRANSFORMATION RATES

POWER STANDARD RATE – RENEWABLE ACCESS SERVICE

This rate is for individually metered Power Class customers served through customer owned transformation and self-generating a portion of their electricity needs using renewable sources as a participant under SaskPower's Renewable Access Service.

Self-Generation Sources - Renewable self-generation sources include solar, wind, flare gas, biomass, geothermal and hydropower generation. All other sources are considered non-renewable.

MINIMUM BILL

The basic monthly charge plus the demand charge.

RECORDED DEMAND

The monthly recorded demand is the maximum kVA demand registered during the current month.

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BILLING DEMAND

The monthly billing demand is the monthly recorded demand, but the billing demand shall not be less than 75 per cent of the maximum billing demand in the preceding 11 months.
