

SaskPower Net Metering Program Checklist

Please refer to the checklist below to help guide you through the Net Metering Process. **If you have any program questions, please email us at: customergeneration@saskpower.com.**

Application Steps:

- Review Net Metering program details (as provided on saskpower.com) and plan your generation project.
 - Make sure you thoroughly research and understand how solar works, what solar size is right for your consumption amount and behaviour, the details of the Net Metering program, costs, and potential savings before committing to a project.
 - Request quotes from multiple vendors.
 - Your vendor designs your project. Ensure they have all documentation ready for the process.
- Submit Net Metering application form via saskpower.com. Ensure you complete the form fully, including all attachments.
- Submit your project to Technical Safety Authority of Saskatchewan (TSASK) for review and apply for an electrical permit.
- Make \$315 payment for interconnection study fee (you will receive an invoice, payment details will be included).
- Review and sign the Quote Letter and Terms and Conditions Document and return to SaskPower. Make \$498.75 payment for bi-directional meter. If there are additional interconnection costs identified, you will be required to pay 25% before SaskPower advances your project. Keep a copy of your signed documents for reference.
- Send the TSASK Electrical Permit Number to newservices@saskpower.com (if not provided earlier in the process).

Installation Steps:

- Contact your vendor to begin construction of your net metering project.
- Once the project is installed, contact your vendor to schedule an onsite inspection with TSASK.
- Confirm that the electrical inspection is complete by TSASK and the bi-directional meter is installed by SaskPower. It is not acceptable to start generating until **both** are completed. Energizing the system without meeting the requirements can cause safety issues and improper billing.

Energization Steps:

- Ensure your generator equipment is configured with the specific generator settings outlined in the SaskPower Study.
- Energize your system following the manufacturer's procedures and confirm everything is working properly.
- Make payment for any remaining interconnection charges (if applicable) (you will receive an invoice, payment details will be included).
